Safety & Security

The 4-1-1 on 9-1-1.

If you have ever accidentally dialed 9-1-1 on your Studio telephone, you probably received a phone call from our Security Department asking if there is an emergency or if everything is okay. Our studio telephone system has a software program that recognizes anytime someone dials 9-1-1 or 9-9-1-1. Since you must first dial a "9" for an outside line then a "1" before the area code it is very easy to hit the "1" twice. This misdial then sends a message to Security stating there was a 9-1-1 call from that phone. Of course, if you have a real emergency and purposely dial 9-1-1, the software will let Security know where the call is made so that we can direct the emergency responders directly to your location.

We do recommend that you call 5555 for all emergencies and our Medical Department or Security Department will make the 9-1-1 call for you. That way our Medical Department can respond right away and we will know where to guide the responders when they arrive.

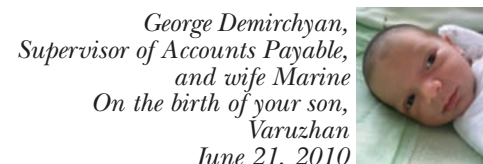

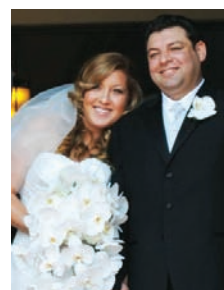

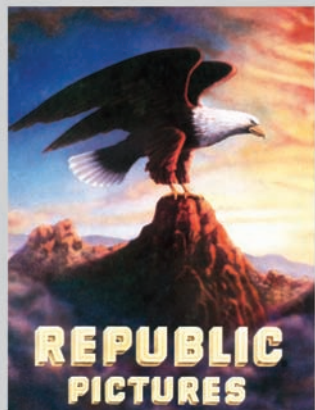

CBS Studio Center continues its efforts to have a positive impact on the environment. In May of this year the Studio hosted "CBS EYE on the Environment" on Stage 15. This event introduced over 50 environmentally conscious vendors to several CBS business units, employees, and other non-CBS production companies. These vendors supply products and services that will help support CBS's efforts to minimize its environmental footprint and become a more sustainable operation day to day.

Another energy savings project CBS Studio Center has begun is installing sensors on the large loading doors of stages so the air conditioning will automatically shut off if these doors are left open. It requires a lot of electricity to keep our stages cool especially during the summer months. In fact, on average, the electricity required to cool a stage is enough to power 15 average sized homes so everyone can help the environment by reminding the folks on a stage to please keep the big door closed as much as possible.
