Many necessities are sacrificed due to long hours or the inability to get away, including seeking regular medical care. *Health Wheels* is a new program that brings healthcare delivery directly to patients where they work **–right here at CBS Studio Center!**

Through *Health Wheels*, MPTF will provide convenient access to routine and preventative health care for those industry family members 13 years and older – everything from physical exams, well-women exams, EKG's, flu-shots and other immunizations, blood pressure checks, and more. *Health Wheels* is a fully functional and state of the art mobile health center that is staffed by an MPTF doctor and licensed vocational nurse to provide basic medical services. *Health Wheels* is just like the other seven brick-and-mortar medical center locations throughout Southern California... it's just on wheels! And just like the other MPTF health center locations, many insurance plans are accepted. Anyone who works in the entertainment industry is eligible for services, NOT just those covered by the Motion Picture Industry Health Plan.

Health Wheels will be onsite weekly every Thursday, starting July 28th. **APPOINTMENTS ARE NOW AVAILABLE** for **Thursday**, July 28th, August 4th, 11th and 18th between 10AM-3PM. *Health Wheels* will be stationed right near the commissary on Residential Street. MPTF staff will also be present in advance of the van's debut outside the commissary between the hours of 11 a.m. - 2 p.m. on Monday, July 25th to answer your questions about *Health Wheels* and the other services and opportunities provided to the entertainment industry by the Motion Picture & Television Fund.

Jamie Barnett - Living Through the Loss

Jamie Barnett has worked in the CBS Studio Center Grip Department since January of 1993. In December of 2001, a little bit of history was made here at the Studio as she became the first and only woman to be named head of a grip department at any major studio in Hollywood. In this capacity, Jamie makes sure that all the shows have a grip best boy and state of the art grip equipment. She also oversees the entire grip rigging on the lot (moving the sets into and out of the stages, hanging backings, track, pipe and scaffolding, installing bleachers, etc.) But there is another very important job responsibility that Jamie "grips" outside of the Studio that not many of us are familiar with. As President of the International Cruise Victims (ICV) Jamie lives and breathes the urgent need to increase the safety and security of the cruise line industry 24 hours a day, seven days a week. And will do so for the rest of her life.

You see Jamie's daughter Ashley, who also worked here at the Studio first in the mailroom, then as a production assistant on the hit series Will & Grace, died on a Carnival cruise in 2005. Ashley was a beautiful, vibrant young woman when she boarded the cruise ship. A day later she died. Her story, What Happened to My Daughter? is featured on the ICV web page. Jamie, along with others in this victims organization who have lost loved ones or have been victims of crime on cruise ships, works tirelessly to educate the public and create awareness of the dangers inherent in taking a cruise.

In 2007, Jamie made the first of several trips to Fort Lauderdale to attend congressionally mandated meetings between the ICV and the Cruise Line International Association (CLIA). Jamie had hopes of convincing the cruise industry to voluntarily agree to safety measures to protect passengers sailing on cruise ships. Such was not to be the case. However, as a result of ICV's tireless dedication over a period of years, in July of 2010 Jamie was proud to travel to Washington, D.C. where she was honored to speak before members of congress in the U.S. Capitol in an expression of gratitude for the passage of the Cruise Vessel Safety and Security Act of

2010. This law, signed by President Obama, will protect millions of passengers who climb aboard cruise ships each year.

Jamie and Ashley's story was also told on the CBS show 48 Hours Mystery - Dark Voyage. Jamie explained how the loss of her daughter motivates her to protect other families whose kids may sail on the next "cruise from hell."

Jamie also has a blog, called Living Through the Loss which is a very personal expression of her struggles facing the horror of losing her daughter, while finding strength in the process to help others.
