
DESCRIPTION OF THE STREET OF T

Travel north on Radford from the CBS parking structure, cross the bridge at the Los Angeles River, then look towards your right. CBS Studio Center, in partnership with the Studio City Beautification Association (SCBA), has created a sculpture walk that extends a quarter of a mile, to where it terminates at the Tujunga Wash and Moorpark Street.

Michael Klausman, President of CBS Studio Center, stored the sculptures on the CBS lot until he and sculptor Karl Johnson could find a permanent place to display them. At the grand opening Michael reminded the audience that, "SCBA is the perfect vehicle to bring together the multiple diverse interests of Studio City."

Thirty years ago SCBA was formed with the mission to make Studio City the most beautiful residential and shopping area in Los Angeles, in fact a park like urban forest! Councilmember Paul Krekorian's commentary opened with the statement, "mission accomplished!"

The designer of the garden was SCBA Board member Francesca Corra of Dirt Diva Designs. Francesca donated her time and talent to the Art Walk as she has to other Studio City beautification projects. Karl Johnson donated his sculptures and both he and Francesca supervised the project to make the Art Walk a reality.

The SCBA received contributions to this project from CBS Studio Center, Studio City Residents Association, Studio City Chamber of Commerce Foundation, Studio City Farmers Market, Los Angeles Office of Community Beautification, and various private entities.

The Art Walk may be "mission accomplished" but SCBA continues its work to beautify Studio City and is moving forward on four new capital improvement projects.





