HEAT RELATED ILLNESSES: KNOW THE SYMPTOMS

During extremely hot and humid weather the body's ability to cool itself is adversely affected. When the body heats too rapidly to cool itself properly, or when too much fluid is lost due to dehydration or sweating, body temperature rises and heat related illnesses may develop.

- Nausea and vomiting
- Fainting

HEAT STROKE (Heat Stroke is a very serious condition and requires immediate medical attention!)

- •Altered mental state
- •Possible throbbing headache, confusion, nausea, dizziness, shallow breathing
- •High body temperature (106°F or higher)
- •Skin may be hot and dry, or may be sweating
- •Rapid pulse
- Possible unconsciousness
